Hab. 3:1-19

e serve the God of times and seasons, who makes all things beautiful in its time
— Ecc. 3:1-2/11

God's Word usually defines the time and season of life as it relates to us both as Church and as individuals — Psa. 31:15/2 Sam. 11:1/Luk. 19:41-44

We discover from scriptures that the midst of the year is ordained a season of spiritual awakening, in God's agenda, as it is written, "REVIVE thy work in the MIDST OF THE YEARS, in the midst of the years make known (your power)"—Hab.3:1-2/6.

- ➤ A season of consecration *Hag. 1:1/ Hab. 3:6*
- ➤ A season of the manifestation of the sons of God *Hab. 3:2-6/17-19*
