- ➤ Ekiti Local Government Area of Kwara State Militant Muslim Fulani herdsmen attack Christ Apostolic Church (CAC) in Eruku on Tuesday, 18th November 2025. About 35 worshippers were abducted, and 5 people were killed. Others were injured, and many more.
- Kagorko Local Government Area of Kaduna Militant Muslim Fulani Herdsmen abducted Rev. Fr. Bobbi Paschal, Parish Priest of Saint Stephens Parish, Kushe Gudu on Monday, 17th November 2025. Father Paschal was killed by abductors on Wednesday, 19th November 2025.
- Agwara Local Government Area of Niger State Militant Muslim Fulani Herdsmen attacked St. Mary's Private Catholic School in Papiri in the early hours of Friday, 21st November 2025. Over 52 students were abducted.

...and several other killings and abductions as earlier circulated.

From all the above, we can see that the church has been under the continuous assault of Jihadist for upward of 15 years, with thousands of lives lost, and several churches burnt down. We can also see a nation under siege that is crying for rescue. This is why we must rise up to the occasion as we engage our spiritual arsenals on the altar of prayer, for the rescue of our dear nation.
